Accessing Your Report: From the Reports menu under Alignment Reports, click Alignment Report

Filter Options

- Filter by class, domain, or time frame
- Use date range filters to quickly adjust how much documentation you view

Set Checkpoint Dates

- From the Date Range drop-down, select Set Your Checkpoint Dates
- Enter your dates, names, and checkpoint periods
- Organization admins can set dates for all users, while teachers and school admins can create and set their own.
